Today, in the Universal Church, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a day when we member that God's Justice is tempered by His Mercy. As the late Holy Father Francis taught us "Jesus reveals the Merciful Face of the Father." We mark this day by having adoration and the chaplet of Divine Mercy from 2pm on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April at Saint Joseph's followed by Holy Mass at 3pm.

A plenary indulgence is gained by those who celebrate Divine Mercy by (1) reciting the Chaplet;

- (2) Sacramental Confession;
- (3) receive Holy Communion.
