## Elements of Lent

#### Prayer

Prayer is the foundation to our relationship with God.

In the words of St. John Chrysostom:

'Prayer is the place of refuge for every worry, a foundation for cheerfulness, a source of constant happiness, a protection against sadness.'

### **Fasting**

To choose to deny ourselves something is to be truly free. Choice is what makes us human; to give up something out of love of God and our neighbour is to be truly free, free from being possessed by our possessions.

Saint Basil the great wrote:

"There is both a physical and a spiritual fast. In the physical fast the body abstains from food and drink. In the spiritual fast, the faster abstains from evil intentions, words and deeds."

### Almsgiving

Of all three, almagiving is the greatest, but without the other two it becomes social action with God as a bystander.







