



## SAINT JOSEPH WITH SAINTS AIDAN & OSWALD

### PALM SUNDAY

Palm Sunday commemorates the triumphant entry of Christ - the anointed one - into the Holy City of Jerusalem (Lk: 19:28-40). The tradition was that if a conquering king entered his new city on horseback, it would indicate that he would be a dominant ruler and the people would be subjected to a forceful subjugation, whereas a monarch who rode on a donkey would be a peacebringer; a uniter; a compassionate ruler. Jesus' entry on a donkey shows the servant-king model of His new kingdom: 'a kingdom of truth and life,

a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace.'
