SAINTS OF THE WEEK

WEDNESDAY 11TH SAINT DAMASCUS (POPE)

Saint Damasus I: born in Spain, he became Pope in 366 and encouraged devotion to the Roman martyrs, writing splendid verses to adorn their resting places. He died in 384.

THURSDAY 12TH OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

Our Lady of Guadalupe: The Blessed Virgin appeared to Saint Juan Diego on the mountain of Tepeyac in what is now Mexico in 1531, miraculously leaving her image on his cloak which is still venerated today. Through Saint Juan Deigo the Blessed Virgin calls all peoples to the love of Christ.

FRIDAY 13TH ST. LUCY

St. Lucy, a Sicilian martyr who died in the persecution of the Fifth Century under the Emperor Diocletian. She is an example of faithfulness and innocence, and her cult was very popular in the early Church.

SATURDAY 14TH ST. JOHN OF THE CROSS

St. John of the Cross, born in 1542, a Carmelite friar and friend of St. Teresa of Avila, with whom he worked for the reform of the order. A poet and mystic, he died in 1591
